

The 146th Open Championship
Weather Forecast for Royal Birkdale
Issued at 7:02 AM , 22 July 2017



HAZARDS: Nil.

HEADLINE: Mostly dry with sunny spells, risk of a shower from mid-afternoon. Light winds with a directional change between morning and afternoon.

0600 to 1200 Saturday	Dry with plenty of sunshine.	E to SE 5-10mph, becoming more variable by 1200
1200 to 1800 Saturday	Further sunshine, however cloud bubbling up with a 30% chance of a shower from 1600. 0-2mm	Variable becoming W to NW 8-12mph, then NNW
1800 to 2400 Saturday	A little cloudier with a 40% risk of a heavier shower through the evening. 0-4mm.	NNW 5-10mph becoming W to NW
0000 to 0600 Sunday	Continuing 40% risk of a shower. 0-4mm.	W to NW 5-8mph

MINIMUM TEMPERATURE 13 CELSIUS

OUTLOOK FOR THE REST OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

Remainder of Sunday: A cloudier start than Saturday with a few outbreaks of rain, this tending to lift and clear during the morning with sunny spells developing, then a 30% chance of a sharp shower through the early/mid-afternoon, this risk then lowering into the evening. Winds: mainly W to NW 5-10mph during the morning, although Variable 5mph at times, then NW 10-15mph through the afternoon/evening. Max temp 19C.
