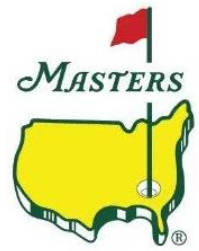


Masters Tournament

7 AM Weather Update Sunday, April 2, 2017



Synopsis: Sunny skies and warm temperatures will make for a beautiful day today before a cold front approaches Augusta on Monday. Increasing chances for rain and thunderstorms can be expected Monday afternoon into the evening. Storms could become severe late in the day with strong winds and locally heavy rainfall. Mostly sunny skies and dry weather returns on Tuesday before the next system brings another round of showers and thunderstorms Wednesday afternoon through early Thursday before shifting east. An upper level low will rotate through the area on Friday, producing mostly cloudy, breezy and cool conditions for the afternoon. Sunny skies and cool conditions continue on Saturday with warmer temperatures Sunday.

9 AM: Sunny and breezy.

Temp: 62F RH: 52%
Winds: ENE 10-15 mph

3 PM: Sunny and warm.

Temp: 80F RH: 30%
Winds: E 5-10 mph

Noon: Sunny.

Temp: 70F RH: 40%
Winds: ENE 6-12 mph

6 PM: Sunny and warm.

Temp: 81F RH: 30%
Winds: E 5-10 mph

Extended Outlook:

Mon: Mostly cloudy and breezy. 70% chance of afternoon showers and thunderstorms.
Low: 61F High: 78F Winds: SE turning S 12-18, G 25 mph

Tues: 20% chance of a lingering early AM shower. Becoming partly cloudy and breezy.
Low: 64F High: 83F Winds: WSW 10-15, G 20 mph

Wed: Partly cloudy, 50% chance of showers and thunderstorms Wednesday afternoon.
Low: 61F High: 84F Winds: SW 6-12, increasing 10-15 G 20mph

Thurs: 60% chance of morning rain and thunderstorms; windy. Clearing by the afternoon.
Low: 65F High: 75F Winds: SW 15-25, G 35 mph

Fri: Partly to mostly cloudy skies, breezy and cooler.
Low: 45F High: 65F Winds: NW 12-18, G 25 mph

Sat: A chilly start, then sunny and pleasant.
Low: 43F High: 69F Winds: WNW 5-10 mph

Sun: Mostly sunny and warmer.
Low: 48F High: 76F Winds: W-SW 6-12 mph
